



Bonita National Alcohol Policy

Alcohol Rules are based on guidelines from RCS Training Florida Association of Restaurant and Lodging.

It is the policy of Bonita National to request ID from any customer (including members, transfer members, guests, or others) appearing to be under the age of 30 and to only accept a driver's license, a state ID card, passport, or a US armed services ID card as proof of age. Also, our establishment will eject and assist authorities in prosecuting any minor in possession of or attempting to purchase alcoholic beverages.

It is also the policy of Bonita National to eject and assist authorities in prosecuting any person involved in drug activity on our premise, which includes the parking lot and any HOA common area.

We reserve the right to refuse service to any customer who is exhibiting signs of impairment. The signs of impairment listed below are not limited to the scope of possible signs that will prevent us from continued serving but are used as a guide for all bartenders and servers.

- Loud or agitated speech
- Ordering drinks rapidly
- Slurred speech
- Stumbling
- Spilling drinks
- Appears drowsy
- Aggressive behavior
- Blood shot eyes
- Sudden change in personality or demeanor
- Inability or reduced ability to understand conversation

Bonita National will never refuse service for the following reasons:

- Race or color
- National origin or citizenship status
- Religion or creed
- Sex or Sexual Orientation
- Age (except to adhere to legal requirements)
- Disability, pregnancy, or genetic information

It is important for all Bonita National Members to understand that while this is a private club, we still must adhere to the local laws regarding selling to minors or to over serving of members and guests.
