



BONITA NATIONAL HOA CHARITY EVENT POLICY

October 23, 2020

Neither the MHOA Board nor the Property Management company will sponsor Charity events.

The Property Management company may lend assistance to our members if they are able to, but the events will be organized by Bonita National Members.

Three events annually:

Fitness (turkey trot)

Tennis (Holiday round-robin)

General Holiday (Christmas/Hanukkah) event (Giving tree, food drive, toy drives)

Requests for Charity events should be submitted in writing to the MHOA Board and Property Management Company for approval 60 days prior to the Event and should include:

1. Date of Event
2. Selected Charity organization for the event request should include a letter from this organization outlining how the donations will be used.
3. All monetary donations are voluntary and should be made via check payable to the Charity organization and collected by the BN members sponsoring the event.

Selected Charity organizations for event requests should be for respected charities that support the community, such as, Harry Chapin, The United Way, Golisano Children's Hospital etc.

Upon approval of the Charity Event request, the BN Member will provide a communication letter that will be forwarded to our Property Management Company for sending out to the Community as well as posting on the BN website, BN Amenity Facebook site, newsletter.

If a Charity Event held at BN has anyone from the Charity organization utilizing any of our facilities and or equipment, a hold harmless letter must be signed by a representative of the organization as well as they must provide a Certificate of Insurance naming Bonita National as an additional insured party.

All events will follow BN Covid guidelines if applicable to the Event.
