MAIN CLUBHOUSE, BLVD BISTRO & CLUBHOUSE TERRACE				
<i>Casual attire, which consists of at a minimum, golf attire for men and women that reflects a country club casual style.</i>				
	Tops	Bottoms	Shoes	Not Allowed
Men:	Collared, bladed, banded, polo, turtlenecks, button shirts, sweaters, zippers, or ½ zips.	Dress slacks, shorts, khakis or chinos, denim (blue, colored, white).	Closed toed and dress shoes.	Hats. Flip flops, or slides.
Women:	Blouses, shirts, collared, polo, button, sweaters, zippers, or ½ zips.	Finger length dresses, skirts, skorts, and shorts. Slacks, capris, and Bermuda walking shorts, denim (blue, colored, white).	Closed or open-toed shoes, leather sandals dress shoes, and fashion boots.	Hats and visors after lunch hours. (4pm dinner hour starts)
Not Permitted for Both Men & Women:	No clothing attire (tops and bottoms) that are too low, tight, short, baggy, faded or, worn with rips, tears, or stringy hem. No cargo pants or shorts, tank tops, cut-offs, or short- shorts. No bare mid-sections, no tee-shirts or graphic shirts, no shirts with slogans or political messages. No sweatshirts, gym clothes (including basketball shorts), or pool attire. No flip-flops, thongs, or slides. Golf shoes may be worn in the Bistro until 5pm. To prevent damage to the wooden steps, members wearing golf shoes are expected to use the elevator or outside staircase rather than the wooden steps. Denim that is faded or worn, has rips, tears, or stringy hem are not permitted.			
Children:	Children up to 10 years old may dress casually, but in good taste when dining. The guidelines for adults apply to children aged 11 years and older.			

<p>POOLSIDE CAFÉ (TIKI BAR) Swimming attire is permitted in the pool areas only. Inside the café (covered seated area), men shall wear shirts and footwear. Women shall wear proper cover-ups and footwear.</p>

<p>CLUBHOUSE, LOBBY, OFFICE, CARD ROOMS, AND MEETING ROOMS Bathing suits and pool attire are not permitted. Shoes are required.</p>

ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY**Portable Communication Devices (cell phones, smart phones, tablets, and readers)**

No oral communication on electronic devices is allowed in any of our dining venues. We ask that you exit the dining area and discreetly take/make your call in the approved public areas. Portable devices are to be set on silent/vibrate mode throughout the Club's facilities. Areas approved for quiet conversations:

1. In the main areas of the Clubhouse, please move away from the dining and bar areas, away from diners and the reception area. The Terrace may be used if not occupied by dining members.
2. In the Men's and Women's locker rooms.
3. Outside the Poolside Café covered dining area or breezeway.
